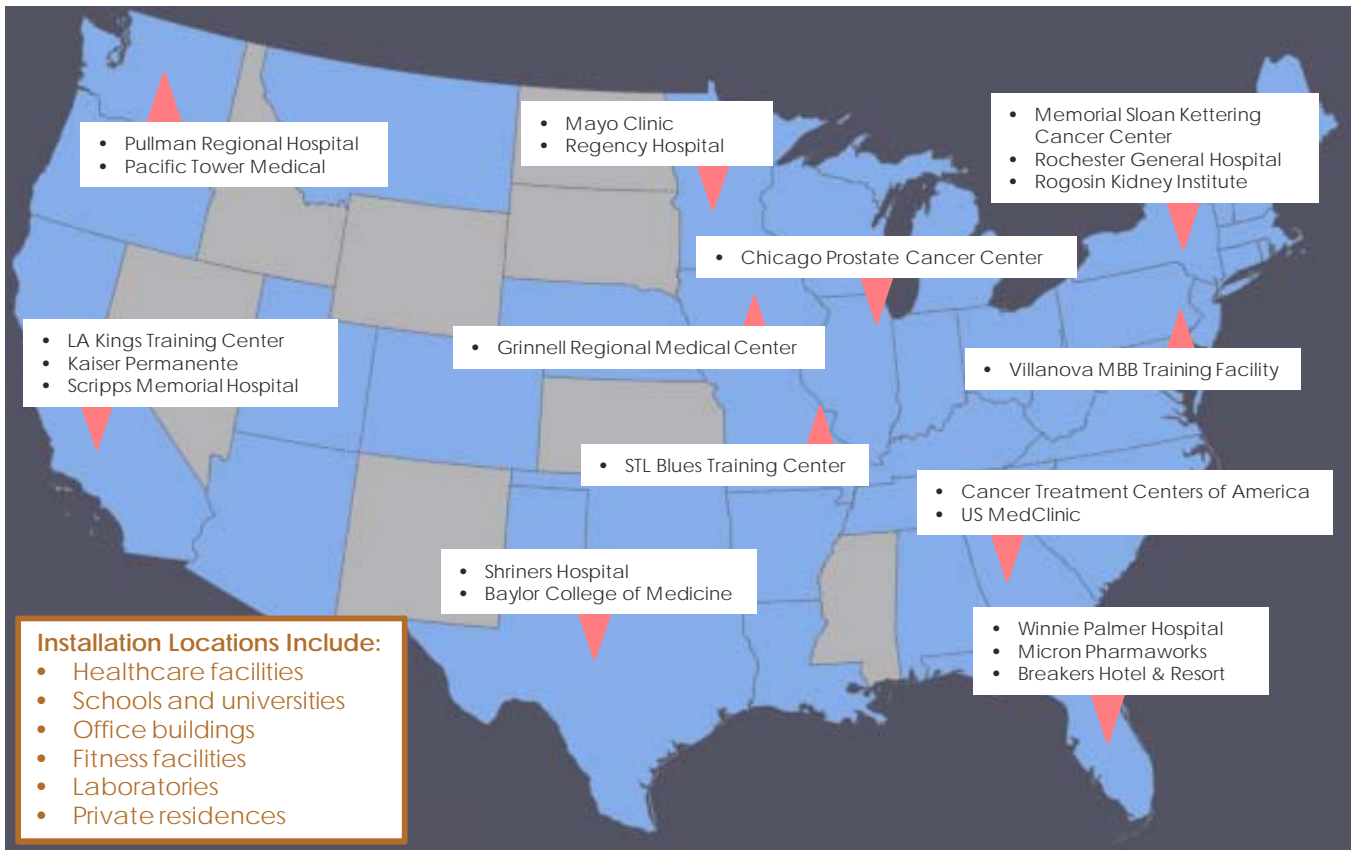

## Where is CuVerro?
